

Visa Information

All delegates from outside the European Union should acquaint themselves with the relevant entry regulations for Ireland. The information can be accessed from the Irish Department for Foreign Affairs web site: <http://www.dfa.ie/home/index.aspx?id=8777>

If you are a citizen of a country that is on schedule 1 you do NOT require an entry visa for Ireland. Citizens of countries which are not on the list must apply for a visa before they travel to Ireland.

Please note that a Schengen or UK visa or residence permission is NOT valid for travel to Ireland. If you are a national of a visa-required country you will need to apply for an Irish visa in advance of travel to Ireland.

Transit Visas ARE required by citizens of the countries listed in schedule 2. All citizens of non-EU countries, whether they require a visa or not, are subject to immigration control at the point of entry to Ireland.

Delegates should allow plenty of time for the Visa Application process.
